DIRECTIONS

TO: Reggie's for Friday Breakfast- 8:30 AM

Take U.S. 90 EAST from Milton to the FIRST Business on the LEFT. About 3/4 miles

TO: Milton Garden Club for Friday Dinner- 5:30 PM

From Highway U.S. 90 in Milton, take State Road 87 NORTH (toward Whiting Field) to the First Traffic Light. Turn RIGHT to the First Street on the LEFT (Alabama St). Turn LEFT. The Garden Club is the FIRST Building on the RIGHT.

TO: Navarre Pavilion- Saturday 10:30 AM

Take U.S. 90 EAST from Milton for about 4 miles to State Road 87 SOUTH. Turn right and stay on State Road 87 through Holley (about 25 miles) to U.S. 98. Take U.S. 98 EAST (Left) (move to RIGHT LANE) to Pavilion on RIGHT which is just a VERY SHORT DISTANCE.
